

On-Site RV Camping FAQ

#1. Where do I go to access onsite camping?

- On-site camping for the Buckeye Motorcycle & Music Rally is located at the Ohio State Fair Campground, adjacent to Historic Crew Stadium.
- This campground is for RV's only. Tent camping is not permitted.
- Access camping via I-71 Exit 111. Proceed west on E 17th Avenue to Korbel Avenue. Follow traffic patterns.

#2. I have a 3-Day RV Camping Pass, what time is check-in and check-out?

- **3-Day Campers** can arrive during 3-Day Camping Check-in Hours, only. If you arrive before or after hours, you will not be permitted access.
- 3-Day Camping Check-in Hours: All hours subject to change **

○ Thursday: 8 AM – 9 PM

Friday: 8 AM - 9 PM

Saturday: 8 AM - 4 PM

• <u>3-Day</u> Camping Check-out: The Campground closes at 12:00 PM (noon) on Sunday, June 30. All campers must vacate the campground by noon.

#3. I have a Single-day RV Camping Pass, what time is check-in and check-out?

- <u>Single-Day</u> Campers can arrive during Single-Day Camping Check-in Hours, only. If you arrive before or after, you may not be permitted access.
- Single-Day Camping Check-in Hours: All hours subject to change**

o **Thursday**: 2 PM

o Friday: 2 PM

Saturday: 2 PM

• <u>Single-Day</u> Camping Check-Out:

- Single-day campers must check-out no later than 11 AM on their respective day of departure.
- A fee will be charged for any Single-Day campers who do not exit the campground by the designated single-day camper check-out time.



#4. How do I check-in for my campsite?

- The Camping Manager will check you in and direct you to your site.
- All campers must have purchased a camping pass for their RV.

#5. Can I bring a companion vehicle with my RV?

- One (1) companion vehicle (standard sized car or SUV) is permitted for towbehind trailers, ONLY. The vehicle towing the tailer is considered the companion vehicle.
- Additional vehicles are not permitted in the campsite, however additional parking permits can be purchased for the general festival parking lots.

#6. How many people can sleep at my campsite?

• Each RV camping pass allows for *up to 6 (six) campers*.

#7. What is the size of my campsite?

- RV camping spaces measure approximately 20' x 45'
- If you have a tow-behind trailer with one (1) companion vehicle (standard sized car or SUV), both must fit within your designated camping space.

#8. What constitutes an RV?

- An RV is defined as any vehicle larger either in length, width or height than a normal sixteen (16) passenger van (anything 20' or longer). All oversized vehicles, trailers, and campers that are towed are considered RVs.
- You MUST have an RV space to bring in an RV, otherwise you will be turned away.
- Buses, Box Trucks and Cargo Vans are *not* allowed within the campgrounds.



#9. Is there ADA camping?

- Yes, Buckeye Motorcycle Music Rally is committed to making the festival accessible to everyone and there will be accessible campsites available.
- ADA Accessible showers will be available within camping.
- An ADA Camping Registration Form will be available closer to the event.

#10. Will RVS and vehicles be searched at the campgrounds during event hours?

 All vehicles will be thoroughly searched. Please review the Allowed and Prohibited Items list in FAQ below.

#11. Can I have an RV delivered to the campground?

 RV deliveries / drop-offs / pick-ups are not permitted. We apologize for the inconvenience.

#12. Can RVs and vehicles leave the campgrounds over the weekend?

- Due to safety concerns, your RV is not permitted to leave the campgrounds once checked in and parked.
- For those with a tow-behind trailer, your companion vehicle, **only**, (standard sized vehicle or SUV) **is permitted** to exit and re-enter.
- Exceptions can be made depending on the specific circumstances.

#13. If I have a ticket to the concerts inside the stadium, can I leave the stadium and go back to the campgrounds during festival hours?

- Yes. Campers who are wearing their ticketed wristbands have re-entry privileges between the festival and campground during festival hours.
- All RVs within the campground, however, must stay in place.



#14. How do I camp near my friends?

- If you want to park near your friends, make sure you arrive at the same time and that you have the same type of camping pass.
- Upon arrival, you will be directed to your camping spots.

#15. What hours can I run my generator?

- Generator hours are from 8 AM 3 AM for Car and RV areas.
- Only generators that have been factory—installed on your RV are permitted.
 No modification. No personal fabrications. No aftermarket installs.
- Please note only generators that are 4kw or smaller are permitted if they are not factory installed in your RV.
- Always be mindful of where your exhaust is aimed and make sure it is never venting into an enclosed area like a neighbor's tent.1

16. Will my campsite have hook-ups?

- All <u>3-day</u> Campers will be assigned a spot in the East & North Campgrounds. These spots feature:
 - o (3) dedicated power connections of 110v, 30amp, and 50amp
 - Dedicated water and sewer connections
- All <u>Single-Day</u> Campers will be assigned a spot in the <u>West</u> Campground.
 These spots feature:
 - o (3) dedicated power connections of 110v, 30amp, and 50amp
 - Dedicated Water connection
 - ** Sewer dump station located near the campground entry gate.
 Please note: there are no dedicated sewer connections in this campground. **

#17. What do I do with trash? Please dispose of trash in the provide receptables.



#18. What can I bring with me into the campgrounds?

- TENT
- E-Z UP / SHADE STRUCTURE (NO LARGER THAN 10'X10')
- TENNIS BALLS OR CAPS USED FOR TENT STAKES
- SLEEPING BAGS, BLANKETS, PILLOWS
- ICE CHESTS/COOLERS
- FOOD AND BEVERAGES/WATER
- ONE CASE OF BEER IN ALUMINUM CANS OR ALUMINUM BOTTLES AND/OR ONE BOX OF WINE PER PERSON IS ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUND.
- NO LIQUOR, GLASS BOTTLES, KEGS OR VENDING IS ALLOWED.
- PRESCRIPTIONS IN THEIR ORIGINAL BOTTLES WITH BOTTLE ATTACHED. ID MUST MATCH NAME ON LABEL.
- CHAIRS
- TRASH BAGS
- FACTORY-SEALED WATER BOTTLES (20 OZ. MAX SIZE) OR EMPTY PLASTIC REFILLABLE WATER BOTTLE
- SMALL, POINT-AND-SHOOT DIGITAL CAMERA
- CELL PHONES
- LIGHTERS AND SEALED PACKS OF CIGARETTES/CIGARS
- NON-AMPLIFIED (ACOUSTIC) MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS
- RV GENERATORS THAT ARE FACTOR INSTALLED
- GENERATORS THAT ARE 4K WATTS OR SMALLER (IMMORDERATE AMOUNTS OF GASOLINE WILL BE CONFISCATED)
- PORTABLE GRILLS-TYPE THAT USE CHARCOAL OR 16OZ CONTAINERS OF PROPANE. (LIMIT ONE CANISTER PER GRILL, PER DAY)



#19. What is not allowed into the campgrounds?

- NO GLASS BOTTLES OF ANY KIND (DRINKS, SAUCES, PICKLES, ETC.)
- NO ALCOHOL FOR MINORS. YOU MUST BE 21+ TO DRINK WITHIN THE CAMPGROUNDS. IF ENTERING WITH ALCOHOL, YOU MUST PRESENT GOVERNMENT ISSUED IDENTIFICATION. 21+ CAMPERS ARE ADVISED TO CARRY THEIR GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION AT ALL TIMES.
- NO DRONES OR REMOTE-CONTROL VEHICLE
- NO DRUGS OR DRUG PARAPHERNALIA
- NO VENDING OF ANY KIND (FOOD, DRINKS, MERCHANDISE, ETC.)
- NO LOOSE PILLS, PILLS WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION, OR EXPIRED MEDICATIONS OF ANY KIND (ALL MEDICATIONS, PRESCRIPTION OR OTHERWISE, MUST BE IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINER)
- NO HOOKAHS
- NO PETS (EXCEPT SERVICE ANIMALS)
- NO MIRRORS (HANDHELD OR PERMANENT WITHIN CAMPING VEHICLE OK)
- NO SPRAY PAINT
- NO PROMOTIONAL FLYERS, PROMOTIONAL/CORPORATE BRANDED BANNERS, OR VEHICLES DISPLAYING SPONSORSHIPS OR ADS
- NO WEAPONS OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DINNER KNIFES, POCKETKNIVES, PEPPER SPRAY, ETC.) OR ITEMS THAT COULD BE USED AS WEAPONS (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO HAMMERS, GOLF CLUBS, ETC.)
- NO TIKI TORCHES
- NO PROFESSIONAL RECORDING EQUIPMENT—PHOTO, VIDEO OR AUDIO (DETACHABLE LENSES, TRIPODS, BIG ZOOMS, GOPROS OR COMMERCIAL-USE RIGS)
- NO FIREWORKS
- NO OPEN CAMPFIRES OR FIRES/FLAMES OF ANY KIND (SMALL GRILLS OK)
- NO SKATEBOARDS, GOLF CARTS, DUNE BUGGIES, OFF-ROAD MOTORCYCLES, SEGWAYS, OR HOVER BOARDS
- NO SPEAKER SYSTEMS



- NO AIR HORNS
- NO BOX TRUCKS, CUBE TRUCKS, 4-WHEELERS, UTILITY TRAILERS OR OVERSIZED FLATBEDS
- NO METAL STAKES (PLASTIC STAKES OKAY)
- NO PROPANE TANKS OVER 160Z THAT ARE NOT ATTACHED TO RV.
- NO GENERATORS THAT ARE LARGER THAN 4KW (UNLESS FACTORY INSTALLED IN YOUR RV)
- NO HELIUM TANKS
- NO WALKIE TALKIES/TWO WAY RADIOS
